
ADULT CONFIRMATION CLASSES:

ball and two smaller pieces of bone that had broken off as well. After a visit to the urgent care unit at Hawthorne Medical, my sister insisted I stay with her, and after a couple of days of ice packs and medication (including a generous dose of TLC) I met with a physician's assistant for an orthopedic doctor and was told that the injury would not require surgery. Since the shoulder was not dislocated it should heal naturally. However, it will need 4 to 6 weeks of rest and immobilization for it to heal. Then I will need several weeks of therapy to strengthen and regain movement in my arm. As a result, I am officially on medical leave. This means I will not be able to celebrate Mass until I regain use of my right arm. Despite my condition I am grateful that: 1. I did not hit my head; 2. I am left-handed; 3. I am blessed with a very caring family (including my Parish family).

Over the next few weeks Fr. Ed Correia and other available priests will cover the weekend Masses, until I am able to return. Please extend to them every courtesy and cooperation. Please pray for them and for me.



<u>LENT</u>: On Ash Wednesday, February 14th. Masses will be at 8 A.M. and 6:30 P.M. Ashes will be distributed at both masses after the homily.

PREPARING FOR LENT: The Church once prescribed very rigorous rules for the Lenten fast. The current rules, however, are much more relaxed. Catholics are only required to fast on Ash Wednesday, the first day of Lent, and Good Friday, the day that Jesus was crucified. Anyone over the age of 18, but under the age of 60, should eat only one full meal on those days, this meal is meatless although they can also have small amounts of food in the morning and the evening. All Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence. There are many approaches, but I recommend that you try the one that best fits your responsibilities of life and your physical condition. During Lent we are also called to take our prayer -life to a highest level. Please consider joining us on Tuesday evenings at 7:00 PM for prayer.
