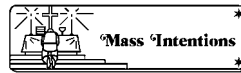

FAITH FORMATION REGISTRATION

Registration for ALL students will take place here at OLOF hall on the weekends of August 24th/25th and August 30th/Sept 1st. Parents can register their children after the 5:00pm Mass on Saturday or after the 9:00am Mass on Sunday.

Registration Fee Schedule:

Grades 1,3,4,5,6,7- \$35.00 per child / \$50.00 per family

Sacramental Years:

Grade 2 – First Penance/First Communion - \$50.00 (\$25 for Catholic School Students)

Grades 8 and 9 – Confirmation I and II - \$70.00 (\$35 for Catholic School Students)



As we begin planning for the 2019-2020 Faith Formation Year, please be aware of some changes brought about as a result of the newly formed Catholic Community of New Bedford North which comprises the parishes of Our Lady of Fatima, St. Joseph/St. Therese and St. Mary.

Beginning in September, classes for Catholic Community of New Bedford North, Faith Formation students in grades 1-7 will be held at All Saints Catholic School and in the Annex, every other Sunday from 11:30 - 1:00. Classes for Catholic Community of New Bedford North candidates in the Confirmation I and II Program will be held every other Sunday in the Unsworth Hospitality Center from 5 – 7 PM. It is anticipated and encouraged that Confirmation Candidates will attend the 7 PM Mass.
