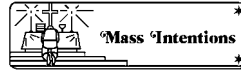

FAITH FORMATION REGISTRATION

Registration for ALL students will take place here at OLOF hall on the weekends of August 24th/25th and August 30th/Sept 1st. Parents can register their children after the 5:00pm Mass on Saturday or after the 9:00am Mass on Sunday.

Registration Fee Schedule:

Grades 1,3,4,5,6,7- \$35.00 per child / \$50.00 per family

Sacramental Years:

Grade 2 – First Penance/First Communion - \$50.00 (\$25 for Catholic School Students)

Grades 8 and 9 – Confirmation I and II - \$70.00 (\$35 for Catholic School Students)



It's easy for us to come up with what we deem to be a great plan for our lives and for the glory of God. It's true that, at times, He allows evils to befall us as part of His permissive Will, but this must be seen as a part of His plan for our holiness, permitting us to trust more deeply in His providential care (See *Diary #1180*).
