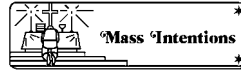

FAITH FORMATION REGISTRATION

Registration for ALL students will take place here at OLOF hall on the weekend Sept 1st. Parents can register their children after the 5:00pm Mass on Saturday or after the 9:00am Mass on Sunday.

Registration Fee Schedule:

Grades 1,3,4,5,6,7- \$35.00 per child / \$50.00 per family

Sacramental Years:

Grade 2 – First Penance/First Communion - \$50.00 (\$25 for Catholic School Students)

Grades 8 and 9 – Confirmation I and II - \$70.00 (\$35 for Catholic School Students)
