**Let Your Voice Be Heard – Again**  
***“Say No to ROE”***

The state legislature has extended the session until January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Please remind the members of the Joint Committee on Judiciary that you oppose the expansion of abortion in **Massachusetts**. Please call the Committee at 617-722-2396 and let them know you are **opposed** to H3320 and S1209 – the ROE legislation. Every telephone call helps! Remember these bills would remove:

The requirement that young girls obtain consent before an abortion

The requirement that efforts be made to save a living baby who survives abortion

The requirement that late term abortions be performed in hospitals

And the bills would allow abortion on demand for all nine months of pregnancy

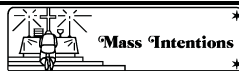

### **COLUMBUS DAY MASS FOR PEACE**

For over 40 years, the Fall River Diocese has had a Procession and Mass for Peace in Fall River on the Columbus Day holiday. While it is not possible to have a procession this year in the midst of the coronavirus pandemic, Bishop Edgar M. da Cunha, S.D.V., will celebrate a **Mass for Peace at 6 p.m. on the Columbus Day holiday, Monday, October 12, in St. Mary's Cathedral**. It will be preceded by a recitation of the Rosary beginning at 5:30 p.m. All guidelines in place for the safe celebration of Mass during the pandemic will be followed including occupancy limits within the Cathedral to provide for social distancing. Anyone who wishes to attend the Mass must pre-register online at [www.fallriverdiocese.org](http://www.fallriverdiocese.org). Seats will be allotted to those who register on a first-come, first-served basis so sign up for the Mass today.
